Together For Good (TFG) provides respite and crisis hosting of children in vulnerable families living without the resources and safety net that most of us have. Currently, four families at Church of the Redeemer are able to host children, and we have a team of others who pray, bring meals, take calls for the TFG office on the weekend, provide transportation, donate clothing, or help with monthly lunches for Moms. The isolation of a pandemic and a shockingly highlighted awareness for many about racial inequality means TFG is looking for more host families at a time when people are asking, "What could I do to be part of lasting change?"
