Priest: Almighty God, our heavenly Father, who in his great mercy has promised forgiveness of sins to all those who sincerely repent and with true faith turn to him, have mercy upon you, pardon and deliver you from all your sins, confirm and strengthen you in all goodness, and bring you to everlasting life; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Officiant: O Lord, open our lips. People: And our mouth shall proclaim your praise. Officiant: O God, make speed to save us; People: O Lord, make haste to help us. Officiant: Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; People: As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Officiant: Praise the Lord. People: The Lord's name be praised.
