# Sermon

## THE NICENE CREED

Molly Niehls has served on Church of the Redeemer's vestry since 2018, and as junior warden for almost as long. On May 2, Molly gave notice of her need to resign. See her message of explanation included below:

When I began my second term on the Vestry at the start of 2021, I didn't know what the next few years would bring. Since then, I got engaged and married, and my husband David and I started to plan and hope for how our family might grow in the near future.

On Ash Wednesday of this year we learned that David has Hodgkin's lymphoma, a type of blood cancer. He began chemotherapy treatments in late March and we expect those to continue into the summer. While we remain hopeful and expectant, along with our doctors, that he will make a full recovery, this diagnosis - and those plans and hopes for our family - have made fresh demands on my time and attention.

Vestry service also and rightly demands time and attention. With all that's before us in the short and long term, I can't give Vestry service that time and attention it deserves. I have decided, with Fr. Paul's support and blessing, to resign from the Vestry and end my term early.

I love Church of the Redeemer, and it has been an honor and privilege to serve on the Vestry. Thank you for trusting me in this role for the past four years.

Please join us in glad thanksgiving for Molly's faithful service. We're thankful for her and David's continued presence in the church and join with them in all their prayers, especially for David's healing, swift recovery, and God's blessings upon their family.
