People: I do. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

# Thanksgiving Over the Water

Celebrant: The Lord be with you.

People: And with your spirit.

Celebrant: Lift up your hearts.

People: We lift them up to the Lord.

Celebrant: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. People: It is right to give him thanks and praise.

Celebrant: We thank you, Almighty God, for the gift of water. Over it the Holy Spirit moved in the beginning of creation. Through it you led the children of Israel out of their bondage in Egypt into the land of promise. In it your Son Jesus received the baptism of John in the River Jordan when the Holy Spirit descended upon him as a dove.

We thank you, Father, for the water of Baptism. In it we are buried with Christ in his death. By it we share in his resurrection. Through it we are made regenerate by the Holy Spirit. Therefore in joyful obedience to your Son, we bring into his fellowship those who come to him in faith, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Now, Father, sanctify this water by the power of your Holy Spirit. May all who are baptized here be cleansed from sin, be born again, and continue for ever in the risen life of Jesus Christ our Savior. To him, to you, and to the Holy Spirit, be all honor and glory, now and for ever. Amen.

## The Baptism

Sustain them, O Lord, in your Holy Spirit, that they may enjoy everlasting salvation through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Let us welcome the newly baptized.

Celebrant and People: We receive you into the fellowship of the Church. Confess the faith of Christ crucified, proclaim his resurrection, and share with us in the royal priesthood of all his people.

## THE PEACE

Celebrant: The peace of the Lord be always with you.

As we remember the peace that we have been given by God through his forgiveness, we also remember that He has given us the ministry of reconciliation with each other. "The Lord be with you," and the response, "And with your spirit." is a translation of Galatians 6:18 and a form of prayer and blessing. May the peace of the Lord be always with you!



As longtime renters, we are grateful to the congregations that have shared their space with us over our decade as a church. We are especially grateful to Calvary for our strong relationship and the use of their building.

As we continue to look for a building to serve as a permanent home, we share these requests:

Help in the search. We will be sending a new round of letters to pastors in the Twin Cities, asking them to keep their eyes and ears open for available property. We know that word of mouth is a powerful tool. If you have any leads, please talk to one of us on the building committee: We've gotten e-mails and tips from some of you, and we appreciate that.

Pray about giving. In consultation with the vestry, we have begun working toward a down payment. Listings move quickly, and we want to be prayerful and prepared.

Meet with us: We hope to meet with households individually to hear questions and concerns, and also to talk about what you might be able and called to contribute. If you consider Church of the Redeemer your church home, we would love to meet with you, regardless of whether you are able to contribute. Watch for an e-mail inviting you to a conversation.

Celebrate, with gratitude. If you were at our annual all-church meeting in February, you heard that we have long had \$9,000 in our building fund. After a series of individual meetings that have included vestry and staff households, we are excited to report that giving commitments now total 10 times that amount – \$90,000. We know that financial commitments involve faith and sacrifice, and we are especially grateful.
